

SENIOR CALENDAR
(Important Information from Guidance)
2008-2009

Fall Semester

- Make your schedule for 08-09 is correct.
- Meet with counselor for a senior credit review.
- Be present on Assessment Day, October 15th to take the Work Keys Career Assessment
- Sign “Transcript Release Form” during credit review.
- Read “Senior College Planning and Financial Aid Guide” and share with parent/guardian.
- Take/retake the SAT or ACT if necessary.
- Narrow College choices and begin working on college applications; pay close attention to deadline dates.
- Compile student activity sheet (9-12 grades)
- Request recommendation letters from teachers and other adults; have letter writers send a copy to guidance.
- Attend Senior College Planning night with your parents/guardians (TBA).
- Read every issue of the Scholarship newsletter and apply for all scholarships for which you are eligible.
- Turn in “Request for Official Transcript” for each application at least 10 school days prior to due date.
- Write personal statement/essay, if required.
- Make every effort to have all 4-year college applications completed and mailed by Thanksgiving break.
- Meet with military recruiters for opportunities in the armed forces, if interested.
- Take/retake the HSAP, October 21-23, 2008, if applicable.
- Attend Ed-Op Day, October 22, during your lunch period, to gather college information, if needed.
- Continue to study, be on time for classes and be mindful of any absences, excused or unexcused.
- Go over your Work Keys results with your counselor.
- Study for 1st semester exams.

Spring Semester

- Continue to read the scholarship newsletter and apply for scholarships.
- Attend Financial Aid night in January.
- Complete the FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid) form on line once your parents have completed their income tax return for 2008.
- Check with individual colleges regarding any specific financial aid forms used in addition to the FAFSA.
- Continue to study, be on time for classes and be mindful of any absences, excused and unexcused.
- Retake HSAP in April, if necessary.
- Attend the Employment Expo if you are looking for summer employment or a job after graduation.
- Complete the Senior Scholarship Survey form to let guidance know where to send your final transcript.
- Submit information about any and all scholarships you have received.
- Meet with your counselor if you are going to have to attend summer school.
- Study for any exams you may have to take.
- Attend graduation practice.
