



At a Glance: Dorchester District Two's 4K Child Development Program

- The 4K Child Development Program is optional for children who are 4 years old on or before September 1, 2019 who meet specific state criteria.
- All children are screened with the DIAL-4 in motor, concepts and language skills. First screening dates are at the end of May.
- Children are scheduled for our 4K classes in a morning session (7:15-11:00 am) or an afternoon session (11:15-2:15 pm).
- The session your child attends depends on where the family resides within the school's attendance zone.
- The curriculum is focused on South Carolina Standards for literacy, math and social skills needed for school success.
- No cost, no school supplies needed except a standard size book bag.
- Parent will be notified by mail of child's status, accepted or wait listed, by July 1st.
- A parent and child orientation is required at the beginning of the school year.
- Conferences and parent participation opportunities are scheduled during the year.
- Regular attendance in 4k is critical. Excessive absences/tardies can lead to dismissal.
- Bus transportation is provided. For your child's safety, an adult must put your child on and get your child off the bus each day.
