

All 10<sup>th</sup> graders/second year high school students will participate in PSAT/PreACT testing unless they opted out. A small group of 11<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> graders will also participate in testing. These students were notified personally. Please be sure that your student arrives on time with their school ID, #2 pencils, a calculator (if they wish to use one), and their district issued device. Students should arrive on campus no later than 9:10 AM. Only the students testing will be at school on October 14<sup>th</sup>. Transportation will pickup and drop-off students on this day. This includes virtual students. Lunch will be provided, but your student may bring their own lunch if they choose. Testing locations will be sent out via blackboard by Friday, October 9 and posted on the 100 hall on Assessment Day. If your student is virtual and is participating in testing, they must come on campus to test. Students utilizing district transportation will be dismissed at 4 PM. After the completion of testing, parents may follow standard school procedures for signing out students.

Students who are **NOT** testing will participate in asynchronous eLearning (hybrid schedule) from home.
