Tips from Teachers

Math: Your child can practice counting to 75. Continue to practice writing the numerals from 0-20 without any reversals. Students can also review 2d shapes and tell how many sides and vertices (corners) each shape has (triangle, square, rectangle, hexagon, and circle). Students can also practice identifying 3d shapes (cone, cube, cylinder, and sphere).

ELA: Continue to work on learning the sight words and all the letters and their sounds. Also, practice identifying the setting and characters in a story, and retelling the story in sequential order.

Daily Skills: Continue to work on self-help skills like zipping and buttoning jackets. Also, work on tying shoes. Remember to review the sight words daily.
