In its thirtieth year, the Senior Citizen Privilege Program is offered by Dorchester School District Two as a way to encourage the involvement of senior residents, age 60 or above, in the schools of our community. The privilege card has no expiration date so it is valid as long as program participants live in the Dorchester School District Two attendance area. Residents age 60 or over and who live in the Dorchester School District Two attendance area may obtain a card by visiting the District Two Administrative Offices, 115 Devon Rd. (Knightsville area) in Summerville, between 8:30 a.m. and 4:00 p.m., Monday through Friday. By simply completing a short application form and showing proof of age, applicants will be issued their Senior Citizen Privilege Card immediately.

The Senior Citizen Privilege Card entitles you to admission to all school athletic events when Dorchester District Two is the host team, with the exception of playoff games. The Privilege Card also entitles you to free admission to most school events that are open to the public. In addition, you will be given a 25% discount on registration fees for any adult or community education classes offered through the Dorchester County Adult Education program. The twenty-five schools in Dorchester School District Two invite community members to attend special events that showcase the talents of students throughout the year. Each month the Public Information Office posts a calendar of events on the district web site at do.ddtwo.org under Calendars. Athletic schedules are also posted on the district's and schools' websites.

Dorchester School District Two offers many volunteer opportunities to include: reading stories to students, mentoring, test monitoring, assisting with special projects or field trips, and so much more. You may volunteer as much or as little time as your schedule allows. Over the years, our community's seniors have volunteered countless hours in our schools. We are so very grateful for the valuable knowledge, experience, and assistance they bring to our classrooms and the support given to our district.
