Gifted Screening Notification

Attention: Third, Fourth and Fifth Grade Students!!!

Referrals are now being accepted for the GATE (Gifted and Talented Education) Program, and will be accepted until September 28th.

Contact your child's teacher and request a "Permission to Test" form if you would like for her/him to be tested. Complete the form as soon as possible, and return the form to the teacher.

Testing will take place between October 24th and November 14th.

Students will be taking an aptitude test known as OLSAT.

Immunization Records Due September 25th

The deadline to have your child's immunization record to Nurse English is September 25th. All schools in DD2 put our students health and safety first, therefore everyone must comply with SC Department of Health and Environmental Control regulations. Any student without a compliant SC immunization record will not be able to attend school after September 25th, until they present one to their school nurse. Thank you in advance for your promptness in this important matter! Again, our number one goal is to provide a safe environment for your child to be educated, thrive & become a leader of themselves and in order to accomplish that, they must be healthy!!

On October 22 and 23 a FREE VISION SCREENING by the Lions Club will be offered to your child. The screening consists of an instant electronic scan of your child's eyes to determine the presence of six eye disorders. This scan takes less than a minute. No physical contact is made with your child, and no eye drops are used. An information sheet will be sent home soon.
